



Lebanon Soccer Club Registration Policies August 2018

Coach-Assistant Coach-Parent Volunteers

ALL coaches, assistant coaches, volunteers and/or potential volunteers must be registered in our new system. Coaches need to be aware of this policy. Coaches and assistant coaches CANNOT run practices or games without being registered.

Often, there are non-coach "unofficial" volunteers helping out at practices at the request or through the blessing of the head coach. As a club we no longer can abide by this behavior. Parents cannot be pulled off the sidelines at games or practices to help out. If you would like, for example, a team parent, they also need to be a registered volunteer before they can fulfill those duties. We understand this may at times cause inconveniences but it's only a matter of time before an unofficial participant gets hurt or hurts a player. The coach and the LSC will be liable in that instance. The simple step of registering will alleviate that liability. We respectfully ask that you comply with this new policy.

There's no charge to register, but every registrant will need a headshot photo, driver's license info, and agree to a background check. Even if a volunteer is simply doing one event and isn't even in contact with children, they still need to register. If not, they'll not be covered under CJSA's umbrella coverage. In terms of things like volunteering at events, if someone gets third degree burns flipping burgers for example, we'll all be liable. Again, simply registering as a volunteer will alleviate this.

- The average turnaround time for background checks is 48 hours, but in some cases will take up to a week. So it behooves everyone (especially coaches) to register ASAP.
- When registering as a volunteer, there's a section that asks you to read concussion protocols. There's no way to disable this, so just go along, please.
- Volunteers will also be asked to check off which coaching certs they have. Just check NONE.

Player Registrants:

Due to the structure of our new registration system, players will have to stick to their age groupings. For example - if a 7y/o wants to move up and play for U10, we can't accommodate. Each age group will have a Boys squad and a Girls squad, except for U06, which will be coed. Here are the age ranges and corresponding teams as they are set up now:

U06: 01/01/2013 - 12/31/2014 REC (Coed)

U08: 01/01/2011 - 12/31/2012 REC

U10: 01/01/2009 - 12/31/2010 REC & COMP

U12: 01/01/2007 - 12/31/2008 REC & COMP

U15: 01/01/2004 - 12/31/2006 REC & COMP

Dues, Late Fees, & Family Discounts:

The dues are as follows:

U06 - \$50.00 with a \$25 late fee if registering after Sep 01.

U08 - \$75.00 with a \$37.50 late fee if registering after Sep 01.

U10 thru U15 - \$100.00 with a \$50 late fee if registering after Sep 01.

We are now only accepting credit/debit card payments.

LSC's Family Discount Policy: After the first two children are registered and paid for, each child registering thereafter shall be free of charge. This year families have to pay for all the children upfront and our Club Treasurer, Gary Haynes, will handle the reimbursement. Moving forward we should hopefully not have to deal with this and it will automatically handled during the registration process.

Registration will have a hard close on 09/15. No exceptions.

Thank you all for your patience as we establish new systems and protocols within the club. We greatly appreciate your time and your support and are very much looking forward to a successful 2018/19 soccer season!
